

Dear Madame Minister of Health,

Traces of pharmaceuticals have been reported in our waters, yet in Canada there are no national standards or laws for pharmaceuticals in drinking water. The risks to human health and aquatic ecosystems from exposure to low concentrations are unclear. I ask the government to fund research into pharmaceuticals in drinking water and to then set rigorous quality standards for the presence of pharmaceuticals in water comparable to the World Health Organization.
